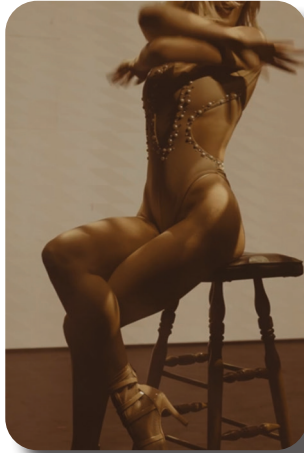


q cabaret: THE NEW KID ON THE BLOCK - VIVA LA DIFFERENCE

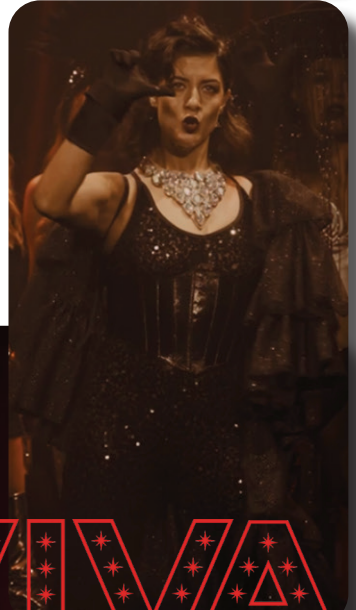
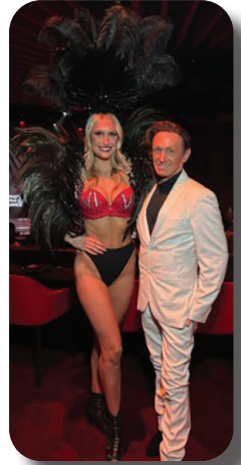
